Site Specific Conditions: <i>(General scope below - to be specified and refined in detail prior to Permit issuance)</i></p> <p>4.1 This permit is issued pursuant to Site Alteration and Fill By-Law 2020-007 (the "Site Alteration By-law") and Site Alteration and Fill Agreement (Title of Agreement) dated this day of month, year (if applicable).</p> <p>4.2 This permit is subject to the conditions outlined in the said Agreement referenced above and the Permit Holder agrees to comply with the terms and conditions of the said Agreement (if applicable or if not applicable, then the following) This permit is subject to the terms and conditions outlined herein and the Permit Holder agrees to comply with these terms and conditions, including any other conditions that may be requested by the Director of Engineering and Development, from time to time and the Site Alteration By-law.</p> <p>4.3 The Permit Holder agrees to grant Town employees and/or any other person(s) working on behalf of the Town, to enter the Site for the purpose of inspecting for compliance with the approved Fill Management Plan or for performing any work necessary to bring the Site into compliance with the Plan, the By-law, and Agreement (if applicable)</p> <p>4.4 A copy of this Permit and the approved Fill Management Plan shall be maintained on Site at all times.</p> <p>4.5 The Permit Holder agrees to be responsible for the activities of their agents, servants, employees, contractors and subcontractors who may create a situation of non-compliance of the Permit. Actions of all persons, including truck drivers, machine operators etc, found altering the site contrary to the approved Fill Management Plan will be considered a contravention of this permit and Agreement, (if applicable) pursuant to the Site Alteration By-law.</p> <p>4.6 Extension to the term of this Permit will be subject to the provisions set out in the Site Alteration By-law.</p> <p>4.7 The Permit Holder agrees to notify the Director of Engineering and Development within five (5) business days prior to commencing any Site Alteration activity.</p> <p>4.8 The Permit Holder agrees to maintain compliance with any other Permit issued by other Agencies having jurisdiction over the site.</p> <p>4.9 The Permit Holder agrees to install all erosion and sediment control measures in accordance with the approved Fill Management Plan prior to any proposed site alteration activities.</p> <p>4.10 Soil quality protocol</p> <p>4.11 Noise By-law and operations schedule</p>
