



ADOPT-A-ROAD AGREEMENT

The Town of New Tecumseth's ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM is a public service program enabling participants to pick-up litter along the right-of-way on certain Town roads. Adopt-a-Road is a way for environmentally-conscious citizens to make a personal contribution to a cleaner environment. Under the program, groups or individuals agree to adopt a section of road right-of-way and keep it clean. The Town recognizes the participant(s) by erecting signs acknowledging their efforts at either end of their designated roadway.

To be completed by Town Representative:

As indicated by their signatures on this agreement, the individual participants are aware of the potentially hazardous nature of the work to be performed and agree to follow the TERMS AND CONDITIONS of the Town's ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM and agree to not hold the Town of New Tecumseth responsible for any injuries or damages that they may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program and agree that signs bearing the individual/group name shall be installed solely at the discretion of the Town.

Adopt-A-Road volunteers must be at least 12 years of age. Youth between the ages of 12 and 18 must be supervised at the roadside by adults. Youth (18 years of age and under) involved in the program must have signed permission from a parent or guardian (19 years of age or older).
