



Alliston Rotary Pool - Admission Guidelines

Patrons will receive a **Daily Admission Bracelet** upon entering the pool during the designated swim time. With this bracelet, patrons are welcome to enter and leave the facility during the designated swim time for short periods of time.

If the pool is at capacity, in/out privileges will not be permitted.

All Users of the Rotary Outdoor Pool are subject to **DAILY ADMISSION FEES**.

5 years and under	Always Accompanied	Always within arm's reach of a parent or guardian, in the water, in proper swim attire	1 adult with a maximum of 2 children  14+
6 to 9 years	Must take a swim test Not able to pass the swim test	Always within arm's reach of a parent or guardian, in the water, in proper swim attire	1 adult with a maximum of 2 children OR 1 adult with a maximum of 6 children in PFD's  14+
6 to 9 years	Must take a swim test Able to pass the swim test	May swim unaccompanied	Parent or Guardian must remain in the pool enclosure to supervise children 9 years and younger
10 years	Admitted into the pool area	May swim unaccompanied	Not Applicable

- Within Arm's Reach – Able to help the swimmer when in the water
- Personal Floatation Device (PFD's) are available for use at no additional cost
