Please Note:

- A wristband will be issued to all participants at time of payment and must be fastened to the participants wrist as you may be asked at any time during your activity to present proof of payment.
- If you do not provide proof of payment, you may be asked to exit the ice and be refused future ice time.
- Payment for skates will be available 60 minutes prior to the skate start time.
- Participants not adhering to the guidelines or designated age categories may be asked to leave the ice surface without a refund.

Identification may be requested to verify age at time of payment. Upon age verification, staff may note the verification on your recreation account.

Ice activities have been scheduled to provide a safe, fun, recreational environment for all participants.

- At all times play must be adjusted to the skill level of all participants on the ice surface.
- All ice activities are programmed for recreational use only, not to be used for coaching/instructional/training time.
- CSA approved skate assists, sledges and wheelchairs are permitted on ice during allocated **skating** times.
- Skates are required to be worn on the ice surface during all scheduled ice times.
- CSA approved helmets are mandatory for all shinny hockey times and full equipment where indicated.

***Open Skate:** is an unsupervised open skate for all ages. Helmets are strongly recommended for all skaters. To participate all children under the age of 16 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult on the ice surface or in the rink area for the duration of the scheduled activity.

***Older Adult Skate:** is an unmonitored skate for older adults.

***Tots Skate & Play:** is an unsupervised skate for the family. Recommended for children under the age of 6. Participants are welcome to bring a stick and puck onto the ice surface. A helmet and gloves must be worn. Nets will be on the ice. All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult on the ice surface or in the rink area for the duration of the scheduled activity. Tots Skate & Play is intended to provide ice time for those children learning to skate and play with a stick and puck. This activity is not intended for advanced skaters or older children.

***Public skate fees apply.**

Opens Skate: Sticks and pucks are NOT permitted on the ice. Helmets are strongly recommended for all participants.

Shinny: is open to any member of the community who is looking for an informal fun game of hockey. Age categories must be followed to keep the game safe, fair, and fun. Please be inclusive of all participants on the ice and gear the play level to those on the ice.

- It is mandatory for all Shinny participants to wear CSA approved hockey helmets, hockey gloves and to use a hockey stick. Full hockey equipment is recommended.
- Nets will be on the ice.
- Shinny fees apply to all shinny activity participants according to their age.
- Goalies are admitted free of charge.

Family Shinny: is open for families to play shinny together as a group of up to 5-6 children per supervising adult. This is not a "learn to skate" drop-in time. Skate aids or assisted learn-to-skate equipment is NOT permitted. Shinny rules and fees apply to all participants on the ice.

A supervising adult may bring their children to family shinny and choose to not participate on the ice however they must remain in the viewable ice surface area or in the rink area for the duration of the scheduled activity for supervision. Play must be adjusted to the skill level of all participants on the ice surface. Family shinny is provided for entry level skaters, for children 12 years and under. Nets will be on the ice.

Shinny 7yrs-13yrs: A Parent/Guardian is permitted on ice with child during shinny 7-13 years. The attending adult must wear a helmet and gloves.

Shinny 14yrs-17yrs: Identification may be requested to verify age at time of payment.

Junior Shinny 16yrs-22yrs: Identification may be requested to verify age at time of payment.

Adult Shinny: Identification may be requested to verify age at time of payment.

Older Adult shinny: Participants are required to wear a helmet and gloves.

"Skating" options – max 60 people per time

"Play" options – max 20 people per time

"Shinny" options – max 20 people per time + 2 goalies or 4 with a rotation.
