Facility Swim Test Administered by Lifeguards

- Facility Swim Tests are required for those 6 - 9 years old, they will receive a **yellow** wrist band if they are interested in taking a swim test. Please speak with Client Services staff upon arrival at the main entrance.
- A Facility Swim Test consists of swimming continuously for 30 meters, and treading water for 1 minute. Facility Swim Tests are administered by a lifeguard during any of the scheduled drop-in swim times.
- Lifeguards will provide a **red** or **green** wristband to everyone 6 - 9 years old upon the completion of a Facility Swim Test.

At any time, a Lifeguard can ask a patron to demonstrate swimming skills for safety reasons. It is up to the discretion of the Lifeguard on duty to make the call for safety concerns. If there are any questions or concerns, the Head Guard or Lifeguards are there to assist.

Alliston Rotary Pool Admission Guidelines

Ages	Supervision Required	Wristband	
5 years & under	Always within arm's reach of a parent or guardian (14+), in the water, in proper swim attire.	Red wristband *no red wristbands in the deep end.	1 parent/guardian with a maximum of 2 children OR 1 parent/guardian with a maximum of 6 children in lifejackets 
6 - 9 years	Children 6 - 9 years who do not pass the facility swim test must always be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian (14+), in the water, in proper swim attire.	May take swim test, if interested in swimming alone Red wristband = must stay within arm's reach of guardian (14+) *no red wristbands in the deep end.	1 parent/guardian with a maximum of 2 children OR 1 parent/guardian with a maximum of 6 children in lifejackets 
6 - 9 years	Children 6 - 9 years who pass the facility swim test must be supervised by an individual (14+), dressed in proper swim attire, pays the daily admission fee, and remains within the pool enclosure.	May take swim test, if interested in swimming alone Green wristband = pass	
10 - 13 years	May swim unaccompanied, must be supervised by an individual (14+), pays the daily admission fee, and remains within the pool enclosure.	Not necessary	
14 years +	Not necessary	Not necessary
