PLEASE NOTE :

- All activities are intended to be Recreational Play: they are self directed and geared for beginners or those who want to practice for fun in a social atmosphere and/or to work on skill development. There is to be no organized coaching during any scheduled recreational ice time.
- Children 9 years and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult 14 years of age or older. Youth 10 – 17 years old do not require supervision when participating in Drop - in Activities. SKATING - ALL AGES will be supervised by a Skate Monitor.
- All participants must check in with staff before being granted admittance to the activity area.
- We recommend that you arrive dressed for your activity with the exception of your specific equipment. Ice skates are mandatory, no shoes are allowed on the ice. CSA approved helmets and full face mask are strongly recommended for all **Skating** participants. It is mandatory for all **Shinny** participants to wear CSA approved hockey helmets, hockey gloves and to use a hockey stick. Full hockey equipment is recommended.
- **NO** FOOD/DRINKS, CELL PHONES/HEADPHONES/EAR BUDS, SHOES, HOCKEY STICKS/BALL/PUCKS/PYLONS, CHILD CAR SEATS/BABY CARRIERS/CHILDREN IN ARMS/STROLLERS ARE PERMITTED ON THE ICE DURING SKATING TIMES.
- INCLUSION & SUPPORT EQUIPMENT; the use of your own Personal Assistive Mobility Device (PAMD) is welcome during Drop-In **Skating** times, however chairs, skate aids, hockey sticks, strollers, toboggans and other such equipment is not an approved PAMD. Please ensure your equipment does not interfere or impact the safety of other participants. Support persons are responsible for all participant transfers. Staff are not permitted to assist with transfers.
- SKATE AIDS; to assist skaters in the beginning stages of development skaters may use their own manufactured skate aid (homemade devices are prohibited) Skate aids may only be used at centre ice and must not damage the ice surface, have sharp edges and/or pose an obvious hazard.
- Participants are responsible for the safety and security of their own items at all times.
- Confrontational behaviour, harassment or destruction of property will not be tolerated and may result in immediate dismissal without refund.
