Pool Descriptions:

Inclusive Swim – This swim is designed for individuals with special needs. We invite all caregivers and individuals to try this quieter swim time. Caregivers are not charged admission. An aquatic wheelchair is available for use by reservation. Please visit www.newtecumseth.ca or phone 705-435-3900 select 2 to speak with Client Services staff.

Family Swim – This swim is designed for adults and children to enjoy together. We invite all caregivers and children to try this quieter swim time.

Public Swim – Public swim welcomes everyone, whether you are an advanced swimmer or new to the aquatic world. These swims are an ideal time for people of all ages to enjoy the sun and play in an aquatic setting.

Lane Swim – During lane swimming, the deep end of the pool is divided into lanes so that determined swimmers can benefit from a structured environment and concentrate on their strokes.

5 years & under	Always within arm's reach of a parent or guardian, in the water, in proper swim attire.	Red wristband *no red wristbands in the deep end.	1 adult with a maximum of 2 children 
6 - 9 years	Children 6 - 9 years who do not pass the facility swim test must always be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian, in the water, in proper swim attire.	Must take swim test Green wristband = pass Red wristband = must stay within arm's reach of guardian (14+) *no red wristbands in the deep end.	1 adult with a maximum of 2 children OR 1 adult with a maximum of 6 children in PDFs 
6 - 9 years	Children 6 - 9 years who pass the facility swim test must be supervised by an individual (14+), dressed in bathing attire, pays the daily admission fee and remains within the pool enclosure.		
10+	May swim unaccompanied	Green wristband	

Facility Swim Test Administered by Lifeguards:

- Facility Swim Tests are required for those 6 - 9 years old, they will receive a yellow wrist band in addition to their admission band.
- A Facility Swim Test consists of jumping into the pool, swimming continuously for 15 meters, and treading water for 1 minute. Facility Swim Tests are administered by a lifeguard during open swim times.
- Lifeguards will provide a **red** or **green** wristband to everyone upon the completion of a Facility Swim Test
- Individuals 10+ receive the regular admission bracelet.

At any time, a lifeguard can ask a patron to demonstrate swimming skills for safety reasons. It is up to the discretion of the Lifeguard on duty to make the call for safety concerns. If there is any concern, the Head Guard or Assistant Lifeguard is there to assist.
