

# Indoor Sport Rental Protocols

## Roadmap to Reopen – STEP 3 / Vaccine Certificate Process



- Vaccine Requirements:** All persons over the age of 12 entering the Town of New Tecumseth recreation facilities will need to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and provide their proof of vaccination along with ID. This includes all spectators, parents, guardians, volunteers etc.
  - The Town will phase in the vaccine requirement for youth aged 12-17. They must have their first dose by September 22<sup>nd</sup> and be fully vaccinated by October 31<sup>st</sup> to participate directly in a sport activity.
  - Youth aged 12-17 must be fully vaccinated as of September 22<sup>nd</sup> to enter the Town recreation facilities for anything other than participating directly in a sport.
  - Children who are under 12 years old will be exempt from providing proof of vaccination.
  - A parent or guardian accompanying a child under the age of 12 must meet vaccination requirements to attend.
  - Medical exemptions must be supported with an official Doctor’s note that meets the provincial requirements.
- Game Capacity Limits:** Indoor sports are permitted, including games / scrimmages and development, with no specified limit on number of people participating in a sports team or league.
- Game Play:** No restrictions on contact for sports or games; 2 meters physical distancing required when not engaged in the sport.
- Safety Plans:** Leagues, organizations and repetitive bookings are required to submit a Covid-19 Safety Plan prior to facility use.
- Masks:** All individuals 2 years and older must wear a mask or face covering when indoors. Masks may only be removed for those entering the sporting surface for the purpose of exerting energy.
- Contact Tracing / Screening:** All persons entering the facility must sign in at the front entrance to screen and contact trace and provide proof of vaccination. The Town will retain the information for a minimum of 30 days as per health unit requirements.
- Player Entrance time:** Participants and parents /guardians assisting youth may enter the facility no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the booking time.
- Visitor Entrance time:** Spectator and visitors may enter the facility no earlier than 15 minutes before the booking time and must vacate the facility immediately following the booking end time.
- Facility Entrance / Exit locations:** All visitors (including participants, spectators, and guardians) must enter the facility through the main facility entrance and exit through the designated exits. The exits will be marked with directional signage and are noted below.

- **Parent / Guardian Responsibility:** Children are to be supervised by a parent / guardian when visiting any Town of New Tecumseth recreation facility when not involved in an organized recreational activity or Town drop-in program / registered program.
- **Facility Capacity Limits:** For physical distancing to be maintained at all times indoor capacity limits for facility spaces have been set based on 50% capacity or less.
- **Capacity Limit Restrictions:** Should the permit holder expect higher spectator numbers please ensure you set your own limits for spectators to adhere to the specific seating capacities. (Example: 1 participant, 2 spectators).

- **Changerooms:** Maximum 2 changerrooms will be allocated per booking.
  - Entrance to changerrooms is 30 minutes prior to booking time. Participants must vacate the changerroom no later than 20 minutes after the booking to maintain cleaning schedules.
  - Due to the BMA changerrooms lower capacity there is a limited number of participants permitted at one time in each room. Please follow the capacities listed on the specific changerroom doors.
  - BMA youth participants are recommended to arrive dressed and ready to play or for permit holders to organize and stagger the participants changerroom use.
  - It is the responsibility of the permit holder / designate to ensure the capacity limits are adhered to.
  - Changing in the hallway is not permitted. Equipment bags are to be kept in changerrooms only, not in the hallway.
  - Extra chairs will be available in the facility hallways for tying skates and putting on helmets and gloves.
- **Facility Amenities:** Water fountains and showers will be available for use.

**Permit holders not adhering to facility protocols may be denied future facility rentals.**
