Meets bi-monthly on the third Wednesday at 6:30 p.m.

Mandate

To provide information and make recommendations to the Mayor and Council with regard to the Town's requirements under the *Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2001* (attached) and the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005* (attached) and to perform duties of the committee as specified under the *Acts*.

As requested by Council:

- a. To advise and make recommendations to Council with regard to accessibility matters within the Town of New Tecumseth.
- b. To review and make recommendations to Council with respect to policies related to accessibility within the Town of New Tecumseth.
- c. To provide background research and information to Council on matters related to accessibility.
- d. To liaise between Council and other community groups, government agencies, business and industry on matters related to accessibility.
