“PARK CLOSURE BY-LAW”

A by-law to provide for the closure of certain parks in the
Town of New Tecumseth during specified times

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that Sections 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary for the health, safety and welfare of its residents to implement a Park Closure By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of New Tecumseth hereby enacts as follows:

1. That no person shall remain in or enter into any Town-owned or leased park between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. of the following day.
(By-law No. 2015-138)
2. This by-law shall be cited as the “Park Closure By-law”.
3. This by-law shall come into force and have effect from and upon the final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 25TH DAY OF JULY, 2005.
