IN THE TOWN OF NEW TECUMSETH

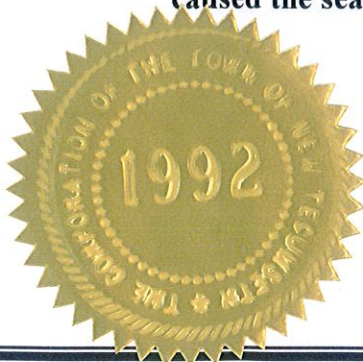
