

Traffic Calming Initial Screening Criteria Form

As per the Town's Traffic Calming Guidelines, a road or road section must satisfy all initial screening criteria to be considered for traffic calming. In cases where the initial screening criteria are not satisfied, front-line mitigation measures may be employed, including the use of temporary radar speed signs and enforcement. Speed limit enforcement is at the sole discretion of the Nottawasaga OPP.

Initial Screening Criteria		Criteria Satisfied?
1	The road or road section must be a local or collector road assumed and maintained by the Town of New Tecumseth.	
2	The road or road section must have a minimum annual average daily traffic (AADT) volume of 900 vehicles.	
3	The road or road section must have a 5-year projected annual average daily traffic (AADT) volume of less than 4,000 vehicles, with the exception of road sections near schools, parks, recreation centres, senior's centres, and other uses generating high volumes of vulnerable pedestrian traffic, as determined by the Town.	
4	The road or road section must have a minimum tangent length of 150 metres.	
5	The road or road section must have a grade that does not exceed 6%.	
6	All reasonable efforts must have been made and failed to address the concerns utilizing other means including engineering, education, and enforcement tools.	
7	The adjacent land use zoning should be primarily residential in nature.
